


- ✓ Person engaged in business to clear or remove snow from private property.
- **DOES NOT** include persons clearing or removing snow using hand-held shovels or equipment that does not require a vehicle for operation.
- ✓ DOES NOT include farmers helping out the community in rural areas as a normal farm practice.

HOW DO I KNOW THEY ARE LICENSED?

- ✓ Ask for proof of the City's business licence.
- Refer to ottawa.ca/consumerawareness for a list of licensed contractors.
- ✓ Look for an orange plate with a valid annual sticker on the snow plow vehicle.

IT'S GOING TO SNOW – BE IN THE KNOW!

DRIVEWAY MARKERS

- ✓ Must be made from **metal**, **plastic**, **fiberglass**, **or wood**.
- ✓ Allowed from October 20 to April 30
- ✓ Installed 5 feet from sidewalk or 7 feet from edge of roadway when there is no sidewalk.
- Logo and telephone number only.
- ✓ Maximum of 2 driveway markers per property.
- ✓ Cannot be illuminated.
- Property owners and contractors are responsible for removing damaged markers and cleaning up debris.

VEHICLE SIGNAGE REQUIREMENTS


- ✓ Name and telephone number must be printed on each side of the snow plow vehicle.
- ✓ Lettering must be a minimum of 15 cm in height, 2:1 colour contrast, and in Arial font.


SNOW DISPOSAL AND STORAGE

- ✓ It is an offence to dump snow on:
 - Private property other than the clients or at an authorized snow disposal facility
 - o **Public property,** such as roadway or sidewalk
 - Accessible parking space
- ✓ 4 hour clean up requirement for any snow illegally dumped by contractor on public property or on an accessible parking space.
